- Get your Indian academic documents certified by 😂 APS.
 - a. Register at the <a> Academic Evaluation Center.
 - b. Assemble documents online.
 - c. Pay APS fee.
 - Start early because results take approx. 12 weeks!

1 You do not yet need your APS result for this.

- Have your interview at Munich Business School.
 - a. Pay application fee.
 - b. Schedule appointment with admissions team.
 - c. Attend interview.
 - d. Sign study contract.
 - e. Get MBS documents: visa invitation letter, acceptance letter and signed study contract.
- Prepare your visa documents.

 Among other documents you will need (see full) checklist for a German national student visa):
 - a. Passport copy and 3 passport pictures
 - b. APS letter and MBS visa invitation letter
 - c. Motivation letter and CV
 - d. Proof of financial means and blocked account for the first year of residency. Previous students recommend:
 - Fintiba Studying in Germany Blocked Account + Health Insurance
 - e. Temporary travel health insurance available from Fintiba

- Book an appointment with VFS.GLOBAL.
